of the Jessie L. Floyd and having the following metes
and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe and Red Oak on road
and running thence with road N. 24-19 $\frac{1}{4}$ feet to iron
pin on road, corner of tract No. 2 thence with line
of tract No. 3 S. 88-88-1545 feet to stake, thence S. 14-50-21
