(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Lillie S. Smith all that certain piece, parcel and
tract of land situate lying and being in the
State and County aforesaid Butler Township near
Cross Roads Church lying between the road
leading from Anderson bridge to Pelham,
and the road leading from Spartanburg to
Greenville, bounded off lands of Lewis
Faulkner, C. Faulkner, J. C. League, and C. W.
Smith and having the following courses and
distances:

Beginning at an iron pin in center of the
Anderson bridge road and run thence S. 85° 4'
E. 20. 11 1/2 feet to a stone Lewis Jenkins corner
on old line, thence N. 84° 30' W. 124.8 feet to a
stone corner on same old line of a Fowlie
corner, thence S. 16° 30' E. 522.2 feet to an
iron pin in the Greenville-Spartanburg road
thence with the said road S. 82° 45' E. 1469.2
feet to a bend in said road, thence S.
87. 30' E. 171.6 feet to a bend in road, thence
N. 69. 15' E. 147.2 feet to an iron pin in
center of said road, a Fowlie corner,
thence N. 57° 45' E. 82.3 feet to a hickory
stump (Rotten) on north side of said
Greenville-Spartanburg road, J. C. League
corner, thence N. 29° 45' E. 89.6.7 feet to an
