thence North 53-00 East 237 feet to a Hickory;
thence North 10-00 East 50 feet; thence North
51-00 East 51 feet to a Hickory; thence North
15-00 East 150 feet to a Black Gum; thence East
15 feet; thence South 10-10 East 131 feet; thence
South 3-30 East 73-0 feet; thence North 79-00
East 20 feet to a Poplar stump; thence South
3-01 East 22-00 feet; thence South 9-15 East
41-6 feet to a Chestnut Oak; thence South
5-50 East 22-50 feet; thence North 87-30 West
112-0 feet across the County Road to a stake;
thence North 83-55 West 152 feet to a large
Hickory; thence South 84-25 West 67-0 feet
