Carrie McCall, her heirs and assigns, (subject
to the like estate herein after reserved to myself)
All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in the State of South Caro-
lina, and County and Township of Green-
ville, known as Lot #73 on a plat recorded
in Plat Book, C., at page 249, Land having the
following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at an iron pin at the inter-
section of Goodrich and Valley Streets, and
running thence with Valley Street S. 36-
15' 16.7 feet to an iron pin, Corner of lot
#4. 56. Distance E. 59-23 E. 50.24 feet to an iron
pin, joint corner of lots 55, 56, 73 and 74.
Distance with line of lot 740.74 in a north-
easterly direction 169.45 feet to an iron pin on
Goodrich Street; thence along with Goodrich
Street N. 64-49 W. 50.95 feet to the beginning corner.

premises, or to collect the rents and profits
thereof during the full term of my natural life.
And I do (signed) by me, jointly, to give a good
and simple title to the purchaser.

Carrie McCall, her

heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
