(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. H. Smith, his heirs and assigns:
All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, on the North side of West Coffee Street, and being known and designated as lot No. 10 as shown on a plan recorded in the office for Greenville County, in Plat Book 2, page 87, and having according to said plan the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a point in center of a 12 inch brick wall on the North side of Coffee St. which point is 9 feet 6 inches East of the corner of Coffee and Richard son Streets, and running thence in the center of said brick wall N. 21° 44' 6.05 feet to a point in said brick wall on an alley, whence with said alley S. 83° 50' 6.21 feet, bisected to a point on said alley, which point is the center of a 17 inch brick wall, thence with the center of said brick wall S. 21° 44' 6.70 ft. runches to a point on the N. side of Coffee St. in the center of said wall, whence with the northern side of said Coffee St. N. 69° 10' 20 ft. 10 inches to the point of beginning.
