TITLE TO REAL ESTATE.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
J. M. Bramlett, his heirs and assigns,
 all that certain piece, parcel or lot
 of land, situated, lying and being in
 the County of Greenville, aforesaid, and in
 the City of Greenville, and being situated
 on the south side of Elkin Street in
 said City. Said lot having the following
 metes and bounds, to-wit:
 Beginning at corner of a stone wall
 on east side of Elkin St. corner of said
 property and running thence S. E. 30° E. 22' 3
 feet; thence N. E. 67° 0' 3 feet; thence N. O. 25° W.
 19' 3 feet to a point on Elkin Street; thence
 along south side of Elkin Street N. E. 30° 34' W.
 50 feet to the beginning corner, and being
 the same lot of land conveyed to
 C. T. Gutman by R. W. Gutman by deed
