(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said C. B. Medlin, his heirs and assigns,

all That piece, or lot of land, in
said Township, County and State of aforesaid con-
taining Fifty-Three (53) acres more or less, bound-
ed on the North by lands of Aug. W. Smith
(approximately 100 feet) on the East by lands of
W. H. Wallace formerly lands of W. H. Wallace on
the South by lands of W. H. Wallace, and on
the West by lands of Mrs. C. B. Medlin, this being
the same land conveyed to Mrs. Meadow by
Anne H. Wallace, by deed dated July 26th 1919, re-
corded in W.M.C. Office for Greenville County
in Vol. 136 page 316.

The said tract has the following
dimensions and distances according to a survey
made by R. G. Dalton, Esq., dated 1916, by
joining at an iron corner office N.
N. 85° 28' E. 1882 ft. to a pine sign on west
side of fence, thence with fence 800
ft. 4-45° N. 12° 30' feet to an iron sign, thence
with line of fence 85° 28' E. 1873 feet
to an iron post, thence with line N.
N. 85° 28' E. 1230 feet to the point
of beginning.

C. B. Medlin to have immediate possession of the said land
