All that certain tract of land, in Butler
County - described as - State aforesaid, and the
eastern - side of the road running from
Greenville to Reidsville, and - having thereto follow-
ing described boundaries - to wit:
Beginning at the corner of C. H. Smith,
and a corner which descends line, S. 94°
W. 6.3 chains to a point in said road leading
to the corner described as 10 1/84 chains to the
corner of the road leading from Pleasant
to Reidsville, thence with the center of said
road S. 77° E. 5.5 chains to a point in said
road where it turns - which said road
is 10 1/84 chains to a point in said
road leading to a point, - hence bearing
said road N. 26° E. 7.5 chains to a stone, - then
N. 73° E. 2.5 chains to a point, - thence N. 55° E. 11.85
chains to a point, - thence S. 51° W. to a stake,
then continuing along the same bearing
to a red oak, the total distance also agreed
bearing being 10.20 chains, - thence by a narrow
path leading S. 60° E. 10.0 chains to a stone;
