W. D. Cassin and E. C. Linnam, their heirs and assigns forever and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto the said W. D. Cassin and E. C. Linnam
