State of South Carolina, County of Greenville.

Cleveland on the East; lot of E. B. Holloway on the north and Brier Street on the west, having a frontage of 29 feet and a depth of 112 feet one side and 114 feet on the other. The above named H. K. Townes took title but his deed was lost before record. He has since conveyed said property to the said W. R. Hale and this deed, conveying any interest the said City has or may have, is for the purpose of perfecting the title in said Hale, his heirs and assigns.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenance to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said W. R. Hale, his heirs and assigns forever.
