land situated, lying and being in Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the south
side of Paris Mountain, about five miles from
Greenville City, containing 52 acres, more or less,
and having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning on a stone; thence N. 72 1/4 E. 9.00 to a
stone; thence S. 58 E. 4.20 to a R. O.; thence N.
63 E. 6.00 to a P. O.; thence N. 18 3/4 W. 22 1/2 to a
stone; thence S. 71 W. 17.60 to a stone; thence S. 32
E. 21.00 to the beginning, and being one of the
tracts of land conveyed to A. B. Davidson by John
C. Davidson on December 2, 1903, by deed recorded in
the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book Vol.
S. S. at Page 241.
