TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS,

on or about the 27th day of March in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and ten by and between the said E. Inman, Plaintiff, and the said W. H. Summers, et al., Defendants, in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 27th day of March 1927, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Carolina Mountains, Inc.

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No.)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Carolina Mountains, Inc., its successors, heirs, assigns, assigns, all the right, title and interest of William Gosnell, et al. Gosnell and Tracy, Gosnell, in and to the following described real estate:

All that certain tract or parcel of land located being and being in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a locust stake on line of Carolina Mountains, Inc. property and measuring thence N. 33° 00' E. 3297 feet to a black gum; thence N. 10° 10' E. 510 feet to a black gum; thence N. 13° E. 730 feet to a black gum; thence S. 10° 10' E. 727 feet; thence S. 35° 30' E. 728 feet; thence N. 79° E. 624 feet to a poplar stump; thence S. 43° E. 1232 feet; thence S. 19° 15' W. 1186 feet to a chestnut oak; thence S. 50° E. 885 feet; thence S. 87° 30' W. 1173 feet across road to a stake; thence N. 13° 55' W. 1572 feet to a large hickory; thence S. 84° 25' W. 670 feet to a water oak; thence N. 87° 30' W. 436 feet to the beginning corner as well more fully appear by reference to plat of same prepared by Geo. W. Huffman, Engineer, dated January 19, 1926, containing 339 sq. acres, plus 1/4 of all the land belonging to the estate of John Chambliss, deceased.
