demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 10th day of June 1929

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that E. Luman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Paris Mountain Caesar Head Company, all the right title and interest of Helen Hudson Bishop, of in and to the following described tract of land: All that certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, Cheepville County, South Carolina, and having according to a survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, 1925, the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pipe in an old stone pipe placed to mark the most southerly corner of the property about to be transferred and at the most northeasterly point of the property belonging to A. B. Davidson and in the westerly line of property belonging to the said Paris Mountain Land Co. formerly the Hadley Thompson tract, and runs: thence (1) along the said Davidson property N 87-20 W 200.0 to an iron pipe, a new corner in said line; thence leaving the said Davidson tract and following along property to be retained by the party of the first part; (2) N 38-20 W 299.0 to an iron pipe placed at the west edge of a small rock cliff; thence (3) N 27-15 W 470.9 to an iron pipe just north of a large pine tree; thence (4) N 20-03 W 887.2 to an iron pipe; thence (5) still along same N 25-50 E 1470.2 to an iron pipe a new corner in the line of lands belonging to the said Paris Mountain Land Company; thence along said last mentioned lands; (6) N 86-21 E 250.0 to an iron pipe corner placed just east of the road leading from Thompson Mountain to Hillhouse Mountain or better known as Paris Mountain Hotel Mountain; thence (7) still along said property N 28-25 E 381.3 to a chestnut oak (down), formerly called the Top of Paris Mountain; and in line of the before

mentioned Hadley Thompson tract and at the most northeasterly corner of the tract about to be transferred thence following along the said Hadley Thompson tract (8) S 25-10 W crossing the above mentioned road 1850.5 to a stake formerly B. O. (gone); thence still along same; (9) S 22-28 W 1617.5 to the point or place of beginning containing 18.67 acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Paris Mountain Caesar Head Company, its successors, heirs and assigns forever.
