or less, and known and designated as tract No. 7, accord-
ing to a subdivision and plat of the estate of James A.
French, made by Stalton & Nease, Engineers, in April
1928, said tract of land is bounded by lands of
J. E. Burton, Joseph A. McCallough, H. N. Davenport
and tract Nos. 6, 5 and 1 of the plat above mentioned
and has such lines and boundaries and courses and
distances as will appear by reference to the above
plat, which is record in the R. M. L. Office for
the County and State aforesaid in plat book 6,
page 276.
The above tract of land represents the divided
interest of the grantee, as fixed by the Court, in the
partition suit hereinunder in which this deed is made.
