KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Paris Mountain Caesar's Head Company,  
 a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at  
Greenville in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of  
Ten Dollars,  
 and other valuable considerations,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. B. Ellis, Jr.  
 all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situated in  
Paris Mountain Township, and more particularly described as follows:

Tract No. 1  
 commencing at an iron pipe on the west side of the old Hotel Road, corner of property or grantor, Paris Mountain Caesar's Head Company, thence along the west side of old Hotel Road north 12-40-26.278' to an iron pipe on the west side of said Road; thence north 2-00-168' to an iron pipe thence continuing with said Road north 20-08-6.241' to an iron pipe on the east side of Road, corner of tract known as Tract No. 2, being transferred from the Paris Mountain Caesar's Head Company to W. B. Ellis, Jr., thence along line of tract No. 2, south 59-104-21.502' to a point on the old Hudson line, thence along that line south 22-28-6.661' to an iron pipe in an old stone pile placed to mark the most south easterly corner of herein conveyed tract and at the most north easterly corner of the property belonging to A. B. Davidson and in the westerly part of property belonging to the said Paris Mountain Caesar's Head Company, formerly the Hadden-Thompson tract; thence along the property of grantor north 35-17-6.250' to an iron pipe on the west side of the old Hotel Road at the place of beginning, the same containing 4.10 acres more or less, and being known as Tract No. 1.

Tract No. 2  
 commencing at an iron pipe on the east side of the old Hotel Road at the most east corner of Tract No. 1 being conveyed from the Paris Mt. Caesar's Head Co. to W. B. Ellis, Jr., thence along the old Hotel Road north 31-24-21.100' to an iron pipe near the east side of the Road; thence continuing with the old Hotel Road north 53-37-11.300' to an iron pipe on the west side of said Road, and located at the south east corner of tract No. 3, being conveyed from Paris Mt. Caesar's Head Co. to W. B. Ellis, Jr., thence along line of said tract No. 3, south 60-37-21.327' to a point on the old Hudson line, thence along that line south 22-28-6.390' to a point at the northwest corner of Tract No. 1, thence along the line of tract No. 1, north 59-04-8.502' to the point of beginning, the same containing 3.75 acres, more or less, and being known as Tract No. 2.

(1) That the premises shall be used for residential purposes only and that the owner or occupant shall at all times conform to all sanitary and police regulations that may be adopted by the directors of this corporation.

(2) That the property shall not be sold, leased or rented to any except white persons.

(3) The "Company" reserves the right to enclose Section A, or any part thereof, of the Company's Development, this being the section on which the hotel and hotel is situated, within a permanent fence and establish and maintain a toll gate or gates at which all persons may be required to pay reasonable admission fees to said section A, if so desired. However, that no charge shall be made to the owners of the lots within said enclosure, their families and guests, to all of whom terms said parties hereto agree.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and

his

heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and

his

heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
