All that certain piece of land situate lying and being near the City of Greenville, on the west side of McAdoo Avenue, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot no 82 of Glenn Park, and having according to plat made by Dalton & Nevers, Engineers November 1925, the following corner and boundary tract:
