KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That RIVERSIDE LAND COMPANY

a corporation chartered under the laws of the state aforesaid, and having its principal place of business at Greenville, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred (\$600.00) Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Mattie Elvira Ourgasson

lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, being a part of the lands of said Company, known as "Riverside," said lot being known and designated on a plat of said lands made by Carter & Fringle, Surveyors, (which plat is of record in said office) as lot number 22 and 23 of block 4 fronting 100 feet on Highlawn Avenue.

Beginning at a point on the north side of Highlawn Avenue, corner of lots 21 and 22 and running thence 6 in an easterly direction with Highlawn Avenue one hundred feet to corner of lot 24; thence with line of lot 24 in a northerly direction to Chicora Avenue; thence with the west side of Chicora Avenue in a northwesterly direction to the intersection of an alley; thence with said alley in a westerly direction 85 feet more or less, to corner of lot 21; thence in a southerly direction with line of lot 21 to the beginning point on Highlawn Avenue - being known as lots nos 22 and 23 of Riverside Land Company.

Together with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and her heirs and assigns forever.

Upon the following conditions, however:—

FIRST—That the property is not to be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to persons of African descent.

SECOND—That no liquor or ardent spirits are to be sold on the property.

THIRD—That no Residence shall be built on said lot to cost less than _____ Dollars but any person may use two or more lots, placing one residence thereon.

FOURTH—That no building shall be erected nearer the street than the building line shown on the said plat, which is _____ feet from all streets.

FIFTH—That no use shall be made of the lot sold, or any part thereof, which would constitute a nuisance or injure the value of any of the neighboring lots.

SIXTH—That the lay out of the lots as shown on said plan shall be adhered to; and no scheme of facing lots in any other direction than that shown on said plat shall be permitted.

SEVENTH—That the Company reserves the right to lay and place or authorize the laying and placing of electric or other street car tracks, sewer, gas and water pipes, electric conduits or pipes, telegraph, telephone and electric light poles, or any other work or instrument of public utility, on or in any of the streets of said Riverside, without compensation to any lot owner.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and _____ heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
