beginning at an iron pin on the east side of an alley which extension (which pin is 9.9 feet from the east side of the concrete road) corner of lot no. 3 and running thence with lot no. 3 N. 67-52 E. 12.6 feet to iron pin on west side of lot no. 4; thence with line of said lot no. 3 89-08 E. 57.6 feet to iron pin corner of lot no. 4; thence with line of said lot 89-02 W. 150 feet to iron pin on Hampton Avenue; thence with Hampton Avenue S. 89-08 E. 57.6 feet to beginning corner.
