

LEASE AGREEMENT dated the 28th day of August, 1930, by and between J. A. Boling, Greenville, S. C. and THE TEXAS COMPANY (Lessee): a corporation of Delaware, having a place of business at Houston Texas Premises Leased. Lessor hereby leases unto lessee a tract of land, with the improvements thereon, in the City of Greenville RFD, #5 County of Greenville State of S. C. described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin two miles north of the Greenville County, S. C. Court House on the Paris Mountain Road and running Northeast along the east side of the road 100 feet to the intersection of the Paris Mountain Road and a cross country road which connects the Paris Mountain Road and U. S. Highway #29, thence Southeast 100 feet to a point, running along the west side of the cross country road, thence Southwest 100 feet to a point, thence Northwest 100 feet to the point of beginning.

Property is bound on the Northwest by the Paris Mountain Road, on the Northeast by the cross country road and on the Southeast and Southwest by the property of J. A. Boling.

(2)—Term. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD for the term of One years from and after the 20th day of August, 1930 but subject to termination by lessee at the end of the first year or any subsequent year upon thirty (30) days' written notice from lessee to lessor, provided however that the lessee, at its option may terminate this agreement any time upon ten (10) days prior written notice in the event of the cancellation or termination in any manner of that certain commission agency agreement between the parties hereto dated Aug. 20, 1930, or any agreement supplementary thereto or in lieu thereof.

(3)—Rental. Lessee agrees to pay the following rent for said premises: A sum equal to one-cent (1¢) for each gallon of lessee's gasoline sold from said premises each month during the term hereof, payable on the 10th day of each month next following the month for which payment is made.

and agrees that, if any installment thereof shall be due and unpaid for ten (10) days after written notice of such default has been delivered to the Sales Manager of lessee at Houston, Texas, lessor shall then have the right to terminate this lease on thirty (30) days' notice to lessee.
 (4)—Maintenance. Lessor agrees to maintain said premises and improvements in good repair during the term of this lease. In the event of his failure to do so, lessee may, at its election either terminate the lease on thirty (30) days' notice to lessor, or make the necessary repairs, at the expense of lessor, and have the right to apply accruing rentals for the purpose of reimbursing itself. If, during the time the premises are undergoing repairs, the use thereof by lessee is materially interfered with, the rent accruing during such period shall be abated.
 (5)—Removal of Property. Lessee shall have the right at any time during the continuance of this lease or within thirty (30) days after its termination to sever and remove all fixtures, equipment and other property of lessee placed on or in said premises by lessee during the term of this or any previous lease, or any extension or renewal thereof.
 (6)—Lessee's Right of Termination. Should the structure on said premises be destroyed by fire or storm, or should lessee for any reason be prevented from establishing or continuing the business of distributing petroleum products on said premises, or should said business for any reason in lessee's judgment become unduly burdensome, lessee may terminate this lease upon giving ninety (90) days' written notice, in which event the rental obligation shall be prorated to the date of such termination.
 (7)—Damages for Defect in Title. Lessor covenants that he is well seized of said premises, has good right to lease the same, and warrants and agrees to defend the title thereto; and to reimburse and hold lessee harmless from all damages and expenses which lessee may suffer by reason of any restriction, encumbrance or defect in such title.
 (8)—Taxes and Encumbrances. Lessor agrees to pay all taxes, assessments and obligations which are or may become a lien on the demised premises and improvements as they become due. If lessor should fail to do so, lessee shall have the right either to make such payment for the account of lessor, in which event it shall be subrogated to all the rights of the holder of such lien, and in addition thereto shall have the right to apply accruing rentals in satisfaction of such obligations; or lessee, in the event of a foreclosure of any such lien and the sale of said demised premises and improvements, shall have the right to buy in said premises and improvements for its own account.
 (9)—Successors and Assigns. This agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and to their respective successors or assigns.

LEASE AGREEMENT dated the 28th day of August, 1930, by and between Beattie Batson, Travelers Rest, S. C. and THE TEXAS COMPANY (Lessee): a corporation of Delaware, having a place of business at Houston, Texas. (1)—Premises Leased. Lessor hereby leases unto lessee a tract of land, with the improvements thereon, in the City of Travelers Rest, S. C. R. F. D. County of Greenville State of S. C. described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin two miles north of the Travelers Rest, S. C. Post-Office and running North along the west side of State Highway #284, 100 feet, to a point, thence West 100 feet to a point; thence South 100 feet to a point, thence East 100 feet to the point of beginning.

Property bound on the North, West and South by the property of Beattie Batson and on the East by State Highway #284.

(2)—Term. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD for the term of One years from and after the 20th day of August, 1930 but subject to termination by lessee at the end of the first year or any subsequent year upon thirty (30) days' written notice from lessee to lessor, provided however that the lessee at its option, may terminate this agreement any time upon ten (10) day prior written notice in the event of the cancellation or termination in any manner of that certain commission agency agreement between the parties hereto dated Aug. 20, 1930, or any agreement supplementary thereto or in lieu thereof.
