 to A.J. Neves by J.M.E. Terry by his deed bearing date of Oct. 10th, 1917, recorded in R.M.C.
 Office Greenville County in Volume 34 at page 75, containing Ten and 00/100 (10.00) acres,
 more or less, according to survey made by J.A. Adams, Surveyor, in April 1921, and having
 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at iron pin J.R. Terry line and running thence S. 59- $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 11.00 to stone,
 J.R. Terry corner; thence N. 5- $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 14.00 to stone D.L. Thompson corner; thence N. 53- $\frac{1}{2}$ W.
