John M. Blatworthy that certain tract of land containing 118 (118.75) acres, more or less situated in the State and County aforesaid, with the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a corner on the south side of the road, thence along said road 21.17 to a corner in said road, bounded by J. M. Whitt and J. P. Whitt; thence N. 74 E. 1160 stake 340; thence S. 35 3/4 E. 77 stake 340; thence S. 31 E. 4.75 stone 34 in the north edge of the road; thence S. 52 1/2 W. 6.36 stone 34 bounded on the east four lines by J.
