All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying
and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, known and
designated as lot No. 149, in Block C; of the subdivision
known as Augusta Court, as shown on a plat
of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County,
South Carolina, in Plat Book 6, at page 124, and
having according to said plat, the following metes
and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a point on a 50 foot unnamed street
joint corner of lots Nos. 48 and 49, and running thence
