Lot No. 1: Beginning at the intersection of Church and Washington Streets and running thence S 17° 30' E. along Washington Street one hundred and fifty-three feet; thence S 70° 30' E. eighty feet, thence in a straight line to Washington Street, and at a point therefore sixty feet from Church Street, thence in a line and along Washington Street, eighty feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to D. B. Davenport by deed dated February 28, 1914, and recorded in office of P. M. R. for Greenville County in Vol. 24, page 412.

Lot No. 2: Beginning at an iron pin on East Washington Street sixty (60) feet from corner of East Washington and Church Streets and running thence S 17° 30' E. 155 feet to an iron pin, thence S 70° 30' E. 65 feet to an iron pin; a low corner of Lola G.
