Leatha Clinton Mitchell:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in County and State aforesaid and situate, lying  
and being in the City of Greenville, being Lot No. 6 of the Overbrook Land Company, sub-  
division and being more particularly described as follows: - BEGINNING at an iron pin on the  
eastern side of the Spartanburg Road, being the southwestern corner of Lot No. 6 (also  
northwestern corner of lot No. 5) and running thence S. 63.14 E. 208.3 feet to an iron pin;  
thence F. 17.03 E. 57.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56.30 W. 209.3 feet to an iron pin,  
the front property line on the Spartanburg Road; thence S. 20.22 W. 82 feet to an iron pin,  
the point of beginning, according to the survey and plat made by H. Olin Jones of the  
Overbrook Subdivision dated September 11, 1913 and recorded in plat book E, page 251.

This being the same property conveyed to the grantor herein, by K. O. Wright, et al,
