"all that certain lot of land in the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, in Ward one of the city of Greenville, on Harley St. beginning at a Point on Harley St. 190 feet from Rutherford St. and running thence S. 2 E. 70 feet; thence S. 89 E. 60 feet; thence N. 2 W. 70 feet to Harley St.; thence N. 89 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
