the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Lewis Barber, the following described real estate, to-wit: certain pieces, parcels and lots of land situated, lying and being in the City of Greenville, lying near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being described and designated as lot No. 24, Tapawee Subdivision map of the late Andrew East side of Ridley Street, recorded in the City Office for Greenville, being surveyed August, 1927, by Delta & Mease, Engineers, the following - metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the east side of Ridley Street, which point is 268 feet back of the intersection of Ridley and Martin Streets, and running thence south to a corner pin, whence W. N. E. 151 feet to another pin on the west side of a road 10 feet wide, thence with the west side of said road 10 feet, 158.6 feet to an iron pin, whence S.
