Know all men by these presents that we, Emmala B. Jones and Elizabeth E. Jones, of the City and County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) to us in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by L. O. Patterson, Executor of the will of Miss Isabel F. Robinson, deceased (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Augustin Robinson (the brother of the said Isabel F. Robinson) and his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in the second ward of the city of Greenville, in Christ Church Cemetery a few feet eastward from the northeast corner of Christ Church building, bounded on the east, south and west by paths or walks in said cemetery, and bounded on the north by the remainder of the lot still belonging to said grantors; the lot intended to be conveyed hereby measuring four (4) feet in width and approximately eight (8) feet in length, being the same lot whereon the said Isabel F. Robinson was buried in March, 1919, and being the southern end of a lot conveyed by Christ Church, Greenville to John M. Jones, the father of said grantors, about sixty years ago; said entire lot being entirely surrounded by walks, beyond which walks said lot is bounded as follows: on the north by a lot of land belonging to Dr. F. F. Earle, on which Mrs. David F. Earle and Sayles Earle are buried; on the east by a lot shown on the plat of said cemetery as belonging to Colonel W. S. Thompson, and upon which Waddy Thompson, Loula McKee Thompson and Samuel Allen Townes are buried; on the south by lots belonging to Heyward and Sabcock, on the corner of which Joseph Heyward is buried; and on the
