In consideration of permission being granted by City of Greenville to use four inches of the square on the west side of the building owned by me known as the Palmetto Building, in order to face the west side of said building with brick, I hereby agree and understand that the four inches of property extending along the western side of my building is the property of the City of Greenville, and that the original front line of the Palmetto Building is the property line between the City of Greenville and myself.

I further agree that in consideration of being allowed to use this four inches of land extending along the west front of my building that said use shall extend only for the life of the present building, and that should said building be destroyed or removed with any new structure erected by myself, my heirs or assigns shall be set back to the original line, which line is four (4) inches east of the present line.
