In consideration of the sum of One Hundred Fifty dollars, payable Seventy Five Dollars within ten days and the remainder on or before October 15th, 1928, I do hereby grant to Textile Hall Corporation, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, the sole right and privilege of entering upon my lot of land on East Washington Street, Greenville, South Carolina, between Academy and Nowood Streets, adjoining the lot of O. M. D. one and erecting thereon temporary building or buildings for the use of the Southern Textile Exposition, and the corporation may go over and across said lot and use the same for storage, concessions or any purpose whatever connected with the said exposition, until the 15th day of November 1928 when this lease shall terminate without notice.

It is understood that whatever buildings are placed on the said lot shall be removed prior to November 15th and the property restored to the condition it is of this time.
