I, the undersigned, Clerk of Court, do hereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of the original record of the same as the same appears in the records of the Court of the County of Greenville, South Carolina, to-wit:

First Tract: Beginning at a stone in the North Carolina-South Carolina State line on the eastern slopes of a hill, being the southwest corner of a tract of land in North Carolina conveyed by James H. Laine and Mary C. Laine, his wife, to E. H. Holmes by deed dated December 29th, 1910, the said deed and record thereof being referred to for the purpose of more specifically locating the said corner which is a well established land corner, and run thence with said State line S. 85° 30' E. 1008 feet to a stake, thence thence with said line S. 42° 21' 11" E. 114 feet to a stake, S. 168 feet to a small sweet gum tree, S. 53° 45' 21" E. 65 feet to a stake in the branch, E. 100 feet to a stake in the branch, E. 100 feet to a stake in the branch, S. 84° 45' 21" E. 46.5 feet to a stake in the branch, S. 62 feet to a pine on edge of bluff, S. 71° 21' 11" E. 11 feet to a large pine, S. 24° 21' 11" E. 165 feet to a large red oak, S. 75° E. 395 feet to a stake in the branch, S. 8° E. 278 feet to a post, here corner, thence still with said line N. 65° 30' E. 360 feet to an iron pipe in place of an old chestnut

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corner, now gone; thence S. 1° 30' 21" E. 614 feet to an old red oak corner; thence S. 7° 50' E. 100 feet to the old Fisher line 1267.5 feet to an iron stake in place of an old stump (now gone), an old marked corner; thence S. 42° 30' 21" E. 534 feet to the Cowanville Road; thence with said road N. 27° 6' feet to a stake, thence N. 11° 15' 21" E. 299 feet to a double black oak on east side of road; thence March 211 feet to a stake in a dry hollow; thence N. 25° 45' 21" E. 1055 feet to a stake; thence N. 82° 21" E. 227 feet to an old pine stump; thence N. 67° 45' 21" E. 6 feet to a stone on east side of road; thence following the road (known as Ridge road, Cowanville road and Butter and Egg road) in a westerly direction to where it crosses the State line, a distance of about 1800 feet to a stake in the State line on the east side of the road; thence with the State line S. 85° 30' E. 753 feet to the point of beginning, containing forty five acres, more or less, be and divided: Beginning at a stake on a J. J. J. survey southeast corner, in an old road, thence along said road the following courses: S. 57° 21" E. 124 feet, S. 75° 21" E. 161 feet, N. 84° 21" E. 315 feet, N. 74° 21" E. 200 feet, S. 73° 21" E. 221 feet, S. 63° 21" E. 316 feet, S. 75° 21" E. 165 feet, S. 69° 21" E. 231 feet, North 68° 21" E. 297 feet, N. 60° 21" E. 132 feet, S. 5° 21" E. 165 feet, S. 70° 21" E. 149 feet, to a pine on old road, at a Fisher corner, thence N. 30° 21" E. 231 feet to a stake, thence N. 36° 21" E. 231 feet to a stake in the John Lankford line, thence S. 87° E. 209 feet, along the Lankford line to said Lankford Lakehead corner, thence along the said Lankford line N. 3° E. 594 feet to Lankford's northeast corner on the North-South Carolina State line, thence along the said State line S. 86° E. 216 feet to Dr. J. J. J. survey southeast corner, thence with J. J. J. survey line S. 4° 21" E. 495 feet to the Beginning corner.

Second Tract: An Undivided One-Half Interest in and to what is known as the Warren A. Fisher tract in Lake Laine described as follows: Beginning at Dr. J. J.
