Whereas, the undersigned were heretofore married and lived together for a period of time as man and wife, but for the past two years and more they have lived apart from each other, and now desire to effect and make permanent such separation by an agreement, now,

Therefore, this agreed by and between the parties hereto, as follows:

That the undersigned Elma B. Campbell, Qui Juris, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, in hand paid by E. J. Campbell, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of the stipulations, covenants, and agreements upon the part of E. J. Campbell, Qui Juris, as herein after set forth, does hereby agree to live apart and separate from the said E. J. Campbell, for the remainder of his or her life, without molestation, hindrance, or interference with either the said E. J. Campbell in his business, social or domestic life, or in any manner whatsoever, and hereby agrees not to encourage, assist, sue out, prosecute, or aid in any way any prosecution or suits of any nature as against the said E. J. Campbell for any charge or cause of action bearing upon, or in relation to his former marital life with the said Elma B. Campbell, and his present past, or future separation from her, and agrees to take no part whatsoever, in any form of action, whether civil or criminal, in relation to his present, past, or future life as her husband; and further hereby releases and forever discharges the said E. J. Campbell from all claims, demands, rights of action or otherwise, for any support, past, present, or future, to her, and also rights of inheritance as to herself; and further from all rights and claims of dower, in and to any property that she may now, or hereafter own, which in this State or elsewhere, and agrees to renounce and waive all such dower in and to any property at any time required, or necessary, that she will attend at such time and place as may be convenient for such purposes; and further hereby releases and discharges

the said E. J. Campbell from any claim or demand for support or protection of said the two children, James Campbell and Robert T. Campbell, present, past, and future, the custody and control of the said children being hereby left entirely and solely to the said Elma B. Campbell.

And the said E. J. Campbell, in consideration of the covenants, stipulations and agreements hereinbefore set forth upon the part of the said Elma B. Campbell, hereby agrees and binds himself not to molest, interfere with, or hinder in any way the said Elma B. Campbell, in her business, social or domestic life, to take no part in any form of action, bearing upon, or in relation to her separate living from him, and hereby releases the said Elma B. Campbell from any obligation or duty to him as wife, or otherwise, and to remain away and apart from her the same as she would not her husband, and further agrees not to interfere with the custody and control of the two children hereinabove mentioned, by hereby releasing such custody and control entirely and solely to the disposition and wish of the said Elma B. Campbell.

This mutually understood and agreed that each of the parties hereto may hereafter live where, and in such manner as he or she desires, or will, without interference in any manner by the other during the life of either, and any interference by any person against either will not be supported in any manner by the other party hereto.

It is specifically understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto, that the said E. J. Campbell is in no wise responsible for any of the past obligations or indebtedness of the said Elma B. Campbell, for herself or the said children, and is in no wise to be responsible for any future legal or indebtedness of the said Elma B. Campbell, either for herself or the said children; nor will the said Elma B. Campbell be under any obligation or duty to assist, molest, or in any
