

Discharge of Bankrupt

In the District Court of the United States

Whereas Harry B. Bates of Greenville, S. C. in said District
has been duly adjudged a bankrupt under the Acts of Con-
gress relating to bankruptcy and appears to have conformed
to all the requirements of law in that behalf.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said Harry B.
Bates be discharged from all debts and claims which have
become provable by said Acts against his estate and
which existed on the 3rd day of June A. D. 1926 on which
day the petition for adjudication was filed by him, ex-
cepting such debts as are by law excepted from the op-
eration of a discharge in bankruptcy.
