all that piece, parcel or lot of land in... Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.*

near the village of Tigerville, containing 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres, more or less, and joining lands of D. O. Head, from McElroy estate, Park, Brain, and others, and being a part of the Hightower place and being the same land conveyed to John T. Head by Nannie L. Southern deed dated Nov. 10, 1921, and recorded in the R. M. L. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 73 at page 291.

Also, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the south side of the State Road, beginning at a stake in the middle of the said State Road northeast of the store door and running thence southwest 3 rods to a stake even with the north corner of the store house and about 15 feet from said corner, thence about due west 6 poles 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a sq. corner south of the dwelling house, thence about due south 2 poles 6 feet 7 inches to a corner stake on the J. P. Southern land; thence about due west about 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods to the McElroy land; thence north to a rock corner; thence with McElroy line down to the east side of Spring Branch; thence south west back across said branch about a rod, thence south up the west side of the said branch nearly due south about 6 rods and 9 feet to a stake corner on the west side of said branch, thence east to the center of said State road and thence with the center of said State Road & to the beginning corner, containing three acres, more or less, this being the same land conveyed to John T. Head by L. J. Brain and Mrs. Nannie Benney, deed dated March 15, 1916, recorded in R. M. L. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 39, page 427.

Also, all that certain parcel and lot of land located in the County and State aforesaid, and north of the City of Greenville on what is known as Park Place and being the front portion of lot no. 1, of block C, having 50 feet frontage on First St., and a uniform width back 100 feet.

Also, all that certain lot and parcel of land in block C of Park Place, and having a frontage on Fourth Street of 50 feet, by a uniform width of 100 feet depth and being the south and rear portions of lots nos. 1 and 2 in block C. of a plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 119, in R. M. L. Office for Greenville County to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing land is a part of the real estate owned by the late John T. Head, Esq. at the time of his death and was assigned to the grantee herein by the Commissioner appointed by the Court to make partition of said estate.
