All that certain tract of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, described as follows in deed of E. L. Maxon, Master to Citizens Bank of Taylor, dated September 3, 1927, and recorded in Deed Book 139, page 110, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County:
 All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being situated in the Town of Taylor, Chick Springs Township, State and County aforesaid, between the National Highway and the Southern Rail road right-of-way: Beginning at a point on or near the National Highway, and running thence N. 83° 26' E. 186 feet to stake thence along line of Bleachers property S. 4° 17' W. 364.4 feet to iron pipe; thence along line of roadway 324.54 feet to steel boudelock, N. 0° 23' W. 285 feet to stake; thence N. 0° 23' W. 3.8 feet to the beginning corner. This being the same property conveyed to Lillian Hudson by W. P. Rainey, September 7th, 1921, Vol. 73, page 362; and Alfred G. Taylor, Executor, August 3rd, 1931, Vol. 62, page 398, and is described herein according to plot thereof made by Dalton & Nevers, Engers, dated June, 1927.
