(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

George St. Few:
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being in the said State
and County aforesaid, in Highland Town-
ship, and on the south side of the Few's
Bridge Road, and being all of tract no. Five
according to plat of D. J. B. F. and E. C. Rees,
property made by H. D. Brockman, Surveyor, on
December 2, 1928, and having the following
metres and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at one iron post in the center
of Few's Bridge Road, corner of tract nos. One
and Five, and running thence along center
of said road S 76° 45' 34.00' to bend in said
road; thence along center of said road S
68° 21' 300' to bend in road; thence along center
of road S 57° 21' 100' to another bend in road;
thence S 46° 34' 500' to another bend in road;
thence S 51° 34' 100' to a slight bend in road,
corner of tracts nos. One and Two; thence S
73° 21' 100' to bend in road; thence along
center of said road S 84° 15' 90' to point
in road on old Few's Cemetery line; thence
along said cemetery line S 22° 12' 2" to center
of old road on Gabrinius Few line; thence
N 62° 50' E 63' to iron post on Few line; thence
S 85° 57' E 1274' to iron post on Ephraim Few
Branch; thence N 17° 53' E 843.5' along A. B.
Cannon line to an iron post in the center
of Few's Bridge Road, this being the beginning
corner, and this being all of tract no. Five
according to said plat of lands; and con-
taining Fifteen (15) acres, more or less.
