A right-of-way sufficiently wide to construct the road as planned, and not less than 25 feet wide on each side of center line of road, on and over all lands, lying along the road, known, as Route No. 211 at any point or points lying between the Name of Place Marietta

and Cleveland which I (or we) may own in whole or in part, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining said highway, with the bridges and causeways thereon.

Line "G" and Line "H" from the "Harvey Robinson Land" to Line "M" then with Line "M" to Line "J" then with line "J" to Middle Saluda River. Present Route 211 to be thoroughly plowed and harrowed wherever abandoned. Top soil from new location to be placed on old road for cultivation purposes. Road top soil road to be built from new road to old road just east of S. & N. R.R. Approx. length 200'. An approach satisfactory to owners to be built from Quist Mill to new Highway.

Together with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise incident to or appertaining. It is agreed that any buildings or fences to be moved from the right of way will be moved at the expense of said County or State.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said right of way and the rights herebefore granted, unto the said State Highway Commission, its successors and assigns, so long as the same shall be used as part of the highway system of this State or Nation.
