Know all men By These Presents, That we, J. I. Humphries,  
J. B. Shoemaker, and H. E. Moore, as Trustees of Pentecostal Holiness Church, Piedmont, South Carolina, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) to us in hand paid, and other valuable consideration at and before the sealing and delivering hereof, by Greenville County, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the State Highway Commission of South Carolina, its successors and assigns, a right of way belonging to the said Pentecostal Holiness Church along the route known as Route S. 655 lying between Greenville, South Carolina, and Pelzer, South Carolina, which is owned in whole or in part by the said Pentecostal Holiness Church, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining said highway, with the bridges and causeways thereon, said strip of land being more particularly described as follows:

A triangle of land on the right of survey Station 395.55 in Grove Township on State Highway Project 655, belonging to Pentecostal Holiness Church, each side being eight (8) feet, eight and a half (8½) feet and twelve (12) feet respectively, and containing 34.59 feet, as per plans of said Project on file in the office of the State Highway Commissioner, Columbia, South Carolina.

Together with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining it is agreed that any buildings or fences to be moved from the right of way will be moved at the expense of said County and State.

To Have and to Hold, all and singular, the said right of way and the rights herein before granted, unto the said State Highway Commission, its successors and assigns, so long as the same shall be used as part of the highway system of this State or Nation.

In Witness Whereof, we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 1st day of April, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight and in the one hundred and fifty-second year of the Independence of the United States of America.
