 Corporation (the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-  
 ledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released,  
 and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and  
 release unto the said Greenville Trading Company,

0 All those three certain lots of land in Greenville County,  
 State of South Carolina, lying on Spartanburg Road, in  
 East Overbrook, each having a frontage on Spar-  
 tanburg Road of 61 1/3 feet, and each running in  
 depth 120 feet to a 20-foot alley, each lot being 61  
 feet wide at rear, being the same land conveyed  
 to W. A. Wallace September 14, 1920, by deed recorded  
 in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 69, page  
 177. The premises above described are the same  
 as conveyed to me by E. Luman, Master, by deed  
 dated January 29, 1926, and recorded in R. M. C. Of-  
 fice for Greenville County in Deed Book 110, page 214.

0 Also all that certain lot of land in Greenville Town-  
 ship, County and State aforesaid, near the White Horse  
 Road, being a portion of Lot No. 9, as shown on plat  
 of Th. D. Workman made by C. M. Furman, Engr. March 24,  
 1924, and being described as follows: Beginning at  
 an iron pin at the southwest corner of Link Street  
 and Gordon Avenue, and running thence with Gordon  
 Avenue S. 80-08 1/2 26.05 feet to iron pin, joint corner of Lots  
 nos. 9 and 8; thence with line of Lot No. 8, S. 10-40 1/2  
 165 feet; thence in a straight line to point on Link Street  
 190 feet from the corner of Link Street and Gordon Ave-  
 nue; thence with Link Street 190 feet to the begin-  
 ning corner. The premises above described are the
