Four and no/100 Dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company its successors and assigns the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures upon, over the and across the property which I own, or in which I have an interest in the township of Greenville County of Greenville and State of S. C. and upon and along the roads, streets, or highways adjoining the said property; said sum is received in full payment for said right, and also for the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right to trim and cut trees along said lines so as to clear and keep the wires cleared at least 25 feet and the right to cut all trees that in falling would reach the wires, and the further right to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto and to tress the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full payment therefor.
