

State of South Carolina Agreement In Re
County of Greenville Sewer Line.

Know all men By These Presents
That

Whereas John A. Curston and Peter
F. Curston the owners and holders of
certain eorages just outside the northern
portion of the City of Greenville, bounded
on the West and South by property of
Utopian Developing Company, and on the
South by property also of C. C. Burgess,
and

Whereas said John A. Curston and
Peter F. Curston desire to build and
construct at their own expense a sewer
line extending through their said
property thence in a southerly direction
through the property of C. C. Burgess and
thence in a westerly direction across
the property of said Utopian Developing
Company, connecting with the Greater
Greenville Sewer District trunk line on
Dickland Creek;

Now Therefore this Agreement entered
into this 22nd day of September, 1938
by and between said John A. Curston
and Peter F. Curston parties of the first
part Utopian Developing Company,
City of the second part and C. C. Burgess,
City of the third part;
Witness this

That you and in consideration of
the mutual covenants hereinafter set
forth said parties do hereby agree
as follows:-

The said Utopian Developing
Company and C. C. Burgess respectively
you and in consideration of the
sum of One (\$1.00) dollar to each
of them in hand paid by John
A. Curston and Peter F. Curston (the
receipt of which is hereby acknow-
ledged) do hereby grant unto the
said John A. Curston and Peter F.
Curston, their heirs and assigns
Over
