Five Dollars to me in hand paid at and
before the sealing of these presents (the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted,
bargained, sold and released and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and re-
lease unto the said J. K. Adams, Wm.
Adams, Wickliffe, and Willie Adams Cole
a One Fifth interest each in and to the
lands herein described, and unto the said
Geny Johnson, Nared Johnson, Sadie Johnson,
Frances Johnson, Helen Johnson, and Lois
Johnson a One Tenth (1/10) interest each
in and to the lands herein described,
and unto the said Curtis Hamby, Richard
Hamby and Mabel Hamby a One Fifteenth
(1/15) interest each in and to the lands herein
described, and to their heirs and assigns
forever, subject however to the following
exceptions, reservations and limitations, to wit:
The grantor herein reserves to him-
self and his assigns the use, benefit
and behoof of the within described premises
for and during the full term of his
natural life. The premises herein granted
and conveyed are as follows, to wit:
All that certain piece, parcel and tract of
land situated, lying and being in
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on
