Whereas, the Charlie Paul and Altha Paul, being husband and wife, residing in the city of Greenville, the said husband having from time to time abandoned the said wife, refused and declined to support her and their minor child, have agreed mutually to separate as man and wife and to forever hereafter live separate and apart, the one from the other, and each to be free from any and all marital obligations or duty involving upon either, to separate, as aforesaid, upon the following terms, and conditions, to-wit:

Article I.

Altha Paul is to have the sole custody of the child, Viola Mae Paul, begotten in wedlock by the Parties hereto, said custody to remain with the said Altha Paul until the said Viola Mae Paul shall arrived at the age of Twenty-One years.

Article II.

Under this Agreement the above Parties agree to live, as aforesaid, forever separate and apart, each renounces all claim and right in and to any of the Property, real or personal, now owned or hereafter to be acquired by either, and the said Altha Paul specifically renounces all right of dower in and to any Property which the said Charlie Paul may now own or hereafter acquire.

To and for the faithful Performance of the said Articles of Agreement hereinbefore set forth, the said Charlie Paul and Altha Paul hereby sign their names in confirmation this the 15th day of August, 1928.
