

Master, by deed dated November 8th, 1911, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 14, page 29.

(3) All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, adjoining Tract "B" and known as Tract "C", having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a sweet gum on the old road; thence N. 3 1/4. 2.00 chains to an angle in road; thence N. 43 3/4 E. 10.90 chains to a stake in Jenkins Bridge Road; thence along said road N. 21 E. 10.00 chains to an angle in road; thence N. 63 E. 4.50 chains to a stake, corner of lot B; thence N. 40 1/4 22.00 chains to a sweet gum; thence S. 49 1/4 24. 31.8 chains to Box Alder on bank of Reedy River, thence with the meanders of said river to the beginning corner; containing 113.25 acres, more or less. This is one of the tracts of land conveyed to S. E. Harrison by J. H. Gray, Master, by deed dated November 8th, 1911, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 14, page 29.

(4) All that piece, parcel and tract of land containing 316 acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in Fairview Township, in the County and State aforesaid, on the northwest side of Cripple Creek of Reedy River, adjoining lands now or formerly of P. L. Huff, G. H. Richardson and others, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stone 3x at the crossing of said creek, by an old line and running thence N. 29 E. with said old line 17.50 to a stone 3x on the old line; thence N. 64 3/4 24. 16.70 to a stone, Richardson's corner; thence N. 63 1/3 24. 33.65 to a stone 3x, P. L. Huff's corner, thence N. 67 24. 19.87 to a stake 3x on a road; thence in a southerly course with the meanders of said road to a sycamore tree, at ford of said Cripple Creek; thence up the middle of said creek as it now runs to the beginning. This being the same tract of land conveyed to S. E. Harrison by William H. Harrison by deed dated February 21st 1882, and recorded in the

(5) All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 125.68 acres, more or less, being known and designated as Tract no 2, assigned to S. E. Harrison in partition suit of H. H. Harrison, et al, vs Richard Harrison, et al, Judgement Roll no 3753 in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, fee simple title to said tract being vested in said S. E. Harrison by Decree of Judge Ernest Gary, December 2nd, 1910, in said proceeding. This being a portion of the tract of land known as the Chapman Place, containing 370 acres more or less, originally conveyed to Edward Harrison, S. E. Harrison and Richard Harrison by Susan V. March, by deed dated January 18th, 1894, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Vol. a. a. a., page 314.

(6) All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being situate in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point marking the extreme south-westerly corner of the within described tract which point marks corner with Tract no 1 and land now or formerly owned by Lempletton Jenkins, and which point is in center of the Jenkins Bridge Road; thence along line of Tract no 1, N. 43 3/4 24. 54 chains to a stone; thence N. 1 1/2 24. 6.42 chains to a point in the center of Cripple Creek; thence along center of said Cripple Creek as the same meanders in a general northeasterly direction, 40 chains, more or less, to a point; thence leaving said creek S. 61 E. 41.20 chains to a stone; thence S. 5 1/2 E. 29.72 chains to a point in the center of said Jenkins Bridge Road; thence along the center of said road, as the same meanders in a westerly direction, 30 chains, more or less, to the point and place of beginning, said tract being a portion of Tract no 2, and containing 316 acres, more or less, according to a survey made by J.
