Know All Men By These Presents: That whereas on the 16 day of Dec., 1925, P. S. Ballenger was duly adjudged bankrupt by the District Court of the United States for the Western District of South Carolina, and that said Bobo Burnett was duly appointed and qualified as trustee of the said P. S. Ballenger in bankruptcy, and is now acting as said trustee, and on the 16th day of March 1926 the said trustee filed a certain petition in said District Court of the United States for the Western District of South Carolina, praying among other things for an order of sale of certain real estate therein mentioned and hereinafter described.
