consultation and advice with attorney's, respectively,  
and being convinced that it is to their inter-  
est mutually to settle finally and forever all  
claims, the one against the other, now and  
forever, do hereby solemnly agree and bind  
themselves, their heirs, executors, ad-  
ministrators and assigns forever, to the following  
articles of agreement and covenants, to-wit:
