Cox, the following described real estate: All those pieces, parcels and lots of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, about two miles from the City limits of the City of Greenville on the White Horse Road, known and designated as Lots four, five, six, seven and twenty-five in Plat Book C, at page 101, Office of P. M. C. for said County, reference to said plat being hereby made for an accurate description of said lots.
