in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said *Montez L. Harris, my one half interest in*

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Greenville* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying and being in the State, County and Township herebefore mentioned, and having following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning with an iron pipe at the corner of Laura Seaffers property, thence along line of said property S. 65.10 N. 173.4 feet to a stake on rear line, thence along rear line S. 0.55 N. 79.4 feet to and thence point corner of property now or formerly belonging to Nicola B. Allen; thence along said line N. 67.50 E. 148 feet, to an iron pipe on road; thence along said road N. 1.50 E. 68.5 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same lot of land conveyed to Mrs. S.A. Williams by W. S. Lynch on the 1st day of April 1920, and filed for record in the office of the Clerk of the County of Greenville, S. C. in Vol. 67 of page 1504 to which reference is hereby made for a more complete description of the property hereby conveyed.

Also, all that other piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being in the State, County and Township herebefore mentioned, just outside of the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville in that suburb of Greenville known as Park Place, and being known and designated as Lot No. 13 in Block 6 of the plat of the said Park Place which plat is duly recorded in the P.M.C. Office for the County and State aforesaid in Book A, at page 119, and said lot contains 75.00 sq. feet more or less and has a frontage on the (highway) Road of 65 feet and a depth of 10 feet.

My interest in the above described property being by inheritance from my mother, Mrs. S.A. Williams, as provided a will filed for probate in the office of the Probate Court in October 1926.

The above described land is *the same* *Mrs. S.A. Williams* conveyed to me by *E. Johnson* on the *15th* day of *Sept.* 1919. Recorded in office of Register of Meane Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book *59*, Page *32*.
