in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said A. P. Hartelle and D. K. Townes, their heirs and assigns; all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

The present water line, including the water mains, running from the Old Paris Mountain Road, in front of my residence lot known as lot No. 2, as shown on the plat of the property of Hartelle and Townes, made by W. W. West February 1920, said line running partly through lot No. 2 and partly through lot No. 6. This deed shall constitute also an easement for the said water line to continue to run through said lands for the benefit of said A. P. Hartelle and D. K. Townes, their heirs and assigns for the period of twenty years from the date of this deed, with the right to continue this water line either along Scott's Alley or along the Old Paris Mountain Road, at any time they may see fit, and with the right to the exclusive use of the same and with the right of ingress and egress across my said premises, in order to maintain said line, or to lay such other water pipes as they may deem necessary along the present course of the line, as the pipe now runs.

It is understood and agreed, however, that the said A. P. Hartelle and the said D. K. Townes, shall allow me to tap the said water lines for the uses of the occupants of lot No. 2 and lot No. 6, hereinabove mentioned only, but that the said A. P. Hartelle and said D. K. Townes own the said water line in all other respects.

These being the same lots conveyed to me by C. L. Martin and by Hartelle and Townes.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by on the day of 19 deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book Page.

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said A. P. Hartelle and D. K. Townes, their heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind my self and my warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said A. P. Hartelle and D. K. Townes, their heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, executors and administrators to person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
