COUNTY OF GREENVILLE. : DEED OF CUSTODY OF CHILD.

Whereas I Bertha Nation of Greenville County, South Carolina am desirous of committ-
ing the care, maintenance, education and support of my child, Broadus J., to W. B. Johnson
and his wife Ora Johnson of Greenville County, South Carolina because of the high esteem,
regard, respect, gratitude, trust and confidence I have and hold for W. B. Johnson and
Ora Johnson,

And, whereas, W. B. Johnson and Ora Johnson agree to accept the care, custody, main-
tenance, education and support of my son Broadus J., during his minority, and further agree
that they will, by proper devise and bequest, make him equal with any other child or
children that may be born to them or adopted by them in the distribution of such separate
and joint estate either and both may die possessed of, and that they will hold and manage
any and all property the said Broadus J. may in any way acquire for his separate use until
he shall have married or reached the age of twenty-one, and will treat said child as if
they were his parents, and cause his name to be called "Broadus J. Johnson".

Know all men by these presents, That I Bertha Nation for and in consideration of the
premises herein stated, have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, custody, main-
tenance, education and support of my child, Broadus J., who was born in Greenville County
on the 13th day of September A. D. 1929 for and during his minority, unto W. B. Johnson
and Ora Johnson.

Together with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by me,
as parent, over and in respect to the said Broadus J., and I particularly contract and
bind myself to refrain from visiting said child after January 1, 1930 during his minority
except upon the joint written request of W. B. Johnson and Ora Johnson, and I do solemnly
bind myself to refrain from making suggestions or requests or dictations relative to the
physical, mental, moral and religious care and training and education of my son Broadus J.,
who will I hope and request hereafter be known as Broadus J. Johnson,

To have and to hold, the said Broadus J. against me and any and all persons claiming
or to claim any interest, right or privilege through me in and to the said Broadus J.

Witness my hand and seal this 27th day of September in the year of our Lord one
thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine and in the 154 year of the Independence of the
United States of America.
