we make this deed of release to him.

hereby acknowledged, we L. H. Hammond, Henry  
Hammond, Roy Hammond, George Hammond,  
Winnif Poore and Lawrence Hammond, children  
and heirs at law of the said Sallie A. Hammond,  
do hereby release any claim, interest, title, claim,  
either in law or in fact, in, to or over the  
tract of land above described.

unto the said J. O. Hammond, his heirs and assigns  
forever, against us and our heirs and assigns  
and any person claiming through us.
